





The rectangular plot is transformed into wild a wetland and grassland that is characteristic of the region. A winding path leads one through tall grasses and dense shrubs. The land starts to descent from the edges of the path. While the garden dips in the centre, the borders of the garden rise into gentle mounds. Mixed Fruit orchards populate the garden while native, wild and forgotten species take root in the left over spaces. Out of this wild garden, designed to develop an ecology in the area, emerge open and secret spaces, spaces for gathering and reflection.



Situated in the corner of the site, this common plot holds the club house, a swimming pool and other recreational spaces. It is situated on a raised platform within the site. It is surrounded by small hillocks, lily ponds, and a wetland that is in turn enveloped by a food forest along its edges. A larger path covers the length of the ground while smaller trails wander off into the plantations. The borders of the site are almost forest-like. Shrubs, grasses and bushes surround a lawn patch along the club house.
